The Brandywine Community Library will:

- Circulate collections of current high-demand, high-interest materials in a variety of formats.
- Offer programs and services for all ages that encourage reading, learning and cultural enrichment and informational entertainment.
- Promote school district cooperative programs that support students at all academic levels.
- Provide reference tools to adults and children including Internet access and computer software.
- Offer interloan services through the statewide ACCESS PA service and the countywide system.
- Welcome all person's to the library and courteously assist them in fulfilling their needs
- Promote an inclusive safe space

Public Relations and Communications

- Maintain social media usage for events and existing/new library services
- Promote library services using "PAForward" Marketing Strategy and maintain Gold Star Status
- Work with the school district and other community organizations in promoting the library and its activities
- Maintain line of communication between the four municipalities
- Advertise events and opportunities at the library
- Elicit feedback and suggestions from patrons
- Build community awareness about collection, services and resources

Programming

- Provide learning opportunities
- Provide family programs and multi-generational interactions
- Provide opportunities for youth development
- Create and foster a Junior Library Board



Buildings and Furnishings

Improve facility by:

- Maintain long term relationship with Diakon
- Identify replacement options for furniture (comfortable /attractive seating, patio)
- Maintain facilities upkeep (paint, cracks, etc)
- Update teen room
- Evaluate space for work, study and homework stations
- Add step stools and changing tables to bathrooms

Finances and Funding

- Identify and expand local funding sources from municipalities and local businesses
- Investigate community based grants and grant writers
- Implement a funding plan for future library changes
- Increase fundraising opportunities and include family friendly options
- Make patron awareness of funding a priority

Technology

- Maintain and upgrade computer equipment and software as able
- Evaluate staff availability to assist patrons one-on-one with technology concerns, find volunteers to assist
- Online presence for collecting donations and fundraising
- Grow digital collection of eBooks and eAudiobooks
