Comments submitted after hours or on weekends will be read and responded to as early as possible the next business day.

Customer Use Policy

The purpose of the library's social media sites is to present issues of interest to the public relating to the Exeter Community Library and its collections, services, and programs.

We expect conversations to follow rules of polite discourse and we ask that participants treat each other, as well as our employees, with respect.

Comments made by the public to these sites are reviewed and, while not edited by Library Personnel, may be deleted if they violate the policy described here. This policy is subject to amendment or modification at any time.

The Exeter Community Library reserves the right to delete comments that:

- a. Use vulgar language
- b. Contain personal attacks of any kind
- c. Include offensive remarks that target or disparage any gender, ethnic, racial, or religious group or otherwise discriminate or evince discriminatory intent against any individual or group based on membership in a legally protected classification
- d. List spam links to other sites
- e. Are clearly off topic

- f. Advocate illegal or bullying activity
- g. Promote particular services, products, or political organizations
- h. Infringe on copyrights or trademarks
- i. Reveal private/personal information (medical, financial, etc.)
