

Friends of the Fleetwood Area Public Library (FFAPL) is a non-profit organization that believes the library is a valuable part of our community and supports its overall mission by funding necessities that would otherwise not be purchased due to decreased government funding. Membership to the FFAPL is \$5 per year and is separate from your **free** library card to the Berks County Library System.

Membership dues and fundraisers organized by the FFAPL provide financial support to the Fleetwood Area Public Library programs and resources available to our community:

- Summer Reading Programs and Prizes
- Family Passes to Reading Museum, Boyertown Historic Vehicles Museum, and Berks History Center
- Craft supplies for kids programs
- Special collection expenses such as Leap Pads, STEM kits, and book club kits.
- Technology for staff and patron use like iPads and laptops as well as technology storage.
- Sponsorship for special programs and speakers for all ages.

The FFAPL is always looking for volunteers to help at various events and fundraisers throughout the year.
